Wildlife and Ecology

The plans will:

- Create more areas of woodland
- Provide new ponds and wetland habitats for amphibians
- Plant more trees and increase the size of the community orchard
- Plant more wildflower species which will increase the number of insects using the site and species that feed on them
- Create more roosting and nesting habitats for bats and birds
- Create habitats for vulnerable species such as hedgehogs
- Create a long term vision for landscape and wildlife that will be delivered through a management plan
- The proposed development will achieve approximately 11.98% Biodiversity Net Gain
